- Hair should be worn in a slick high bun- no bangs or wispies)
- The butterfly headpiece should be securely bobby pinned in on the left side of the bun.
- Costumes have been steamed and should remain wrinkle free

BARRETT-

- Shirt tucked underneath pants. Shirt completely buttoned (one unbuttoned at collar is ok if needed)
- Vest fully buttoned on top of the shirt.
- Hair sprayed a little bit and combed to give a cleaner and more secure look.
- Black Ballet Slippers
- Black socks underneath black ballet slippers.

- The hair bow should be securely fastened in and seen from the front
- The 2 shoe bows should be put over the shoe once it is on.

DURA:

- Black socks
- Black oxford tie tap shoes
- Shirt should be untucked
- Pants are running long and may need to be hemmed. The pants should rest at the bottom of the ankle bone with shoes on
